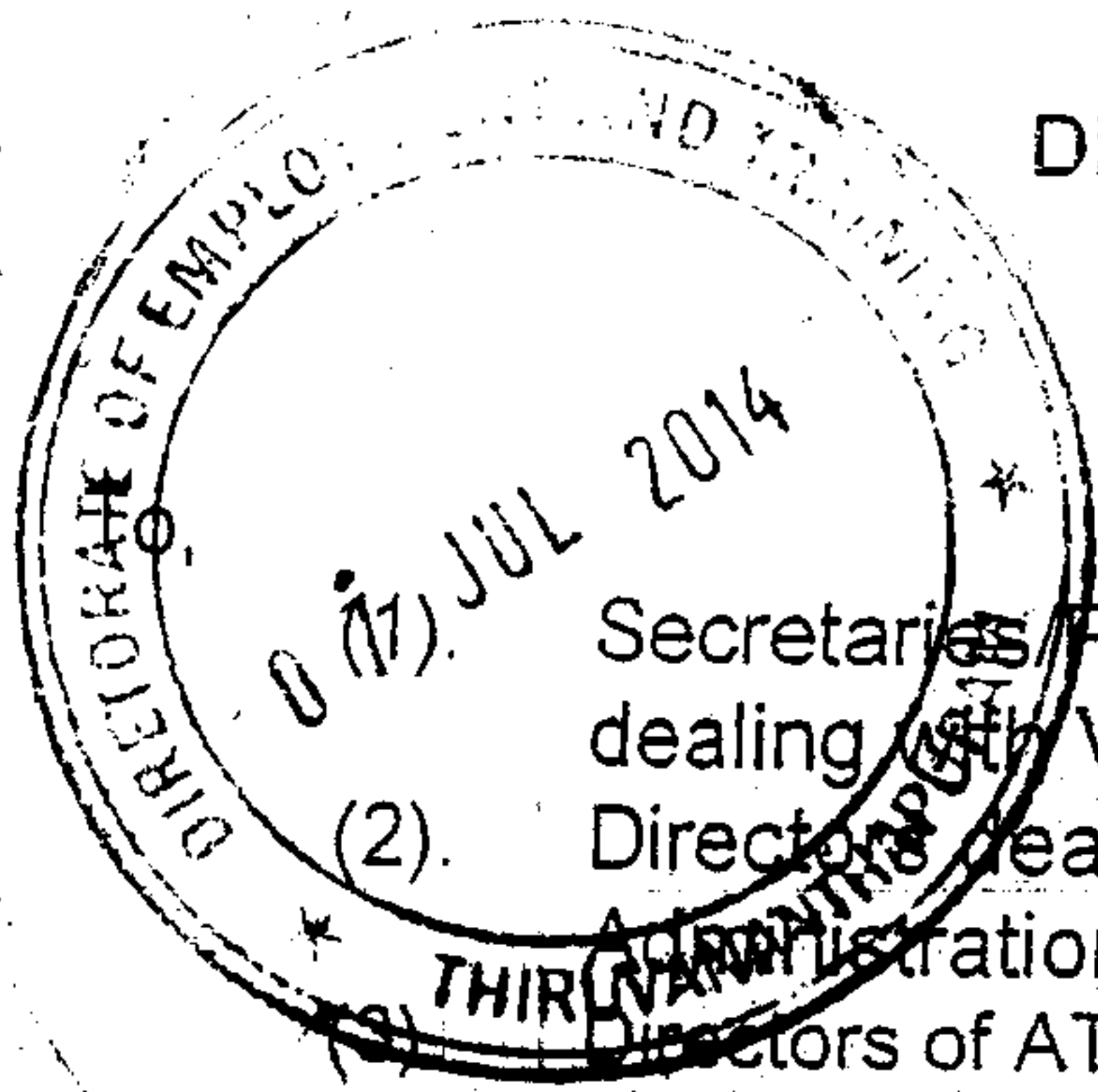

This is to inform that core groups were formed by M/o L&E to review and revise the curriculum of various trades covered under CTS/ATS/SDI schemes of DGE&T. Mentor Councils with participation from academia, industry and Champion ITIs were formed for guidance and support to these core groups. These core groups have examined the syllabi of various trades covering 11 sectors and recommended to introduce 21 new curricula of trades covered under CTS.

The Sub-committee of NCVT on Norms and Courses, during its meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2014, approved the recommendation of core groups for introduction of 21 new trades covering 11 sectors under CTS. The list of 21 new trades is as:




