ORDER

As per the letter read as 1st paper above, the Director of Training furnished a report of the Petition Redressal Cell Committee of the Directorate of Training on the allegation against Sri. G. Gokul, U.D. Clerk, Directorate of Industrial Training regarding harassment against Smt. I.J. Rakhi, I.D. Clerk of Directorate of Industrial Training. In the meanwhile Smt. Rakhi submitted a petition read as 2nd paper above, before Government, on the same issue. Considering the seriousness of the allegation, Sri. Gokul was placed under suspension from service as per Govt. Order read as 3rd paper above pending further enquiry and finalization of disciplinary proceedings. As per Govt. Order read as 4th paper above an enquiry officer was appointed to conduct the detailed enquiry into the allegations. The enquiry officer conducted the enquiry and submitted the detailed enquiry report to Government.

Government have examined the enquiry report in detail. The enquiry revealed that the allegations raised against Sri. Gokul could not be substantiated due to lack of evidence. Therefore Government hereby finalize the disciplinary proceedings initiated against Sri. G. Gokul by exonerating him from all the charges levelled against him and to reinstate him in service with immediate effect. Sri. Gokul is allowed to continue in the Directorate of Training since he has been exonerated from all the charges levelled against him. However the Director of Training should ensure that Sri. Gokul and the petitioner Smt. Rakhi should be posted in different sections.

Orders on regularization of the period of suspension of Sri. Gokul will be issued subsequently.
