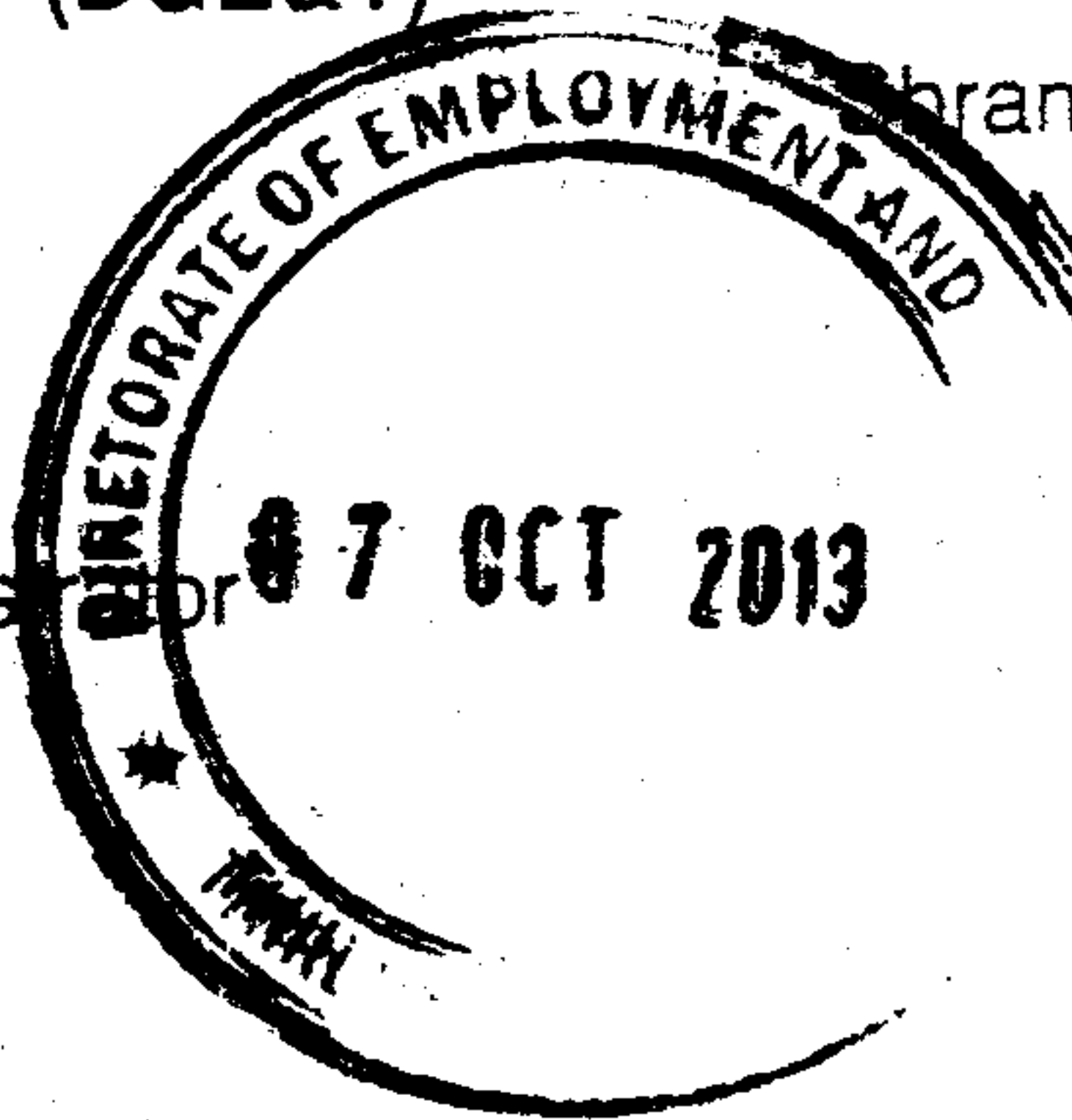

Subject: Issue of de-affiliation orders.

Sir,

The letter from the State Directorate of Rajasthan, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Punjab and Uttar Pradesh have been received, requesting to issue the de-affiliation order to various Private ITIs of their state on the basis of inspection/evaluation conducted by the state directorate. It is prolific to mention here that the NCVT Sub-Committee in its meeting held on 15.03.2013 as item No. 03 of the minutes decided the guidelines for de-affiliation procedure, post engagement of QCI as below:-

On receipt of complaint/ recommendation of de-affiliation from State Directorate, show cause notice should be issued to the institute along with copy to respective State Directorate.

- (a) If reply is not received within 21 days, a reminder will be sent to the institute. Again, if reply is not received from the institute in the 21 days, it will be presumed that the institute is not interested in running trades/units.
- (b) Issue for withdrawal of affiliation will be placed before the NCVT Sub-Committee for consideration and order will be issued according to the decision of the Sub-Committee.
- (c) If the institute is not accredited by QCI, institute would be required to get accreditation from QCI for continuation of affiliation. The recommendation of the QCI will be placed before the NCVT sub-committee for decision.
- (d) However, if an institute request for de-affiliation of certain trades/units and the same is being forwarded by the State Directorate, will be directly submitted to NCVT Sub Committee for its decision and direction.

It was again decided by NCVT Sub Committee in its meeting held on 26.09.2013 as item no 02 of minutes that before directing the institute to get accredited from QCI for continuation of its affiliation, the views / comments of State Directorate should also be obtained on the clarification, if received from the institutes in response to show cause notice issued to them. Accordingly, the clarification received from the institute will be forwarded to State Directorate for their comments/ observations.

In view of above, State Directorate should send their comments / observations with in ten days of receipt of clarifications, so that the same could be put up for the forthcoming NCVT Sub- Committee meeting for further action.
