This is in continuation to this office letter of even no. dated 30th August, 2010 forwarding therein power norms for various trades under Craftsmen Training Scheme.


It was brought to the notice of DGE&T that power norms for eight trades namely 1. Digital Photographer 2. Fashion Technology 3. Stenography (English) 4. Hospital Housekeeping 5. Front Office Assistant 6. Dress Making and 7. Hair & Skin Care are much higher than actual requirement. Accordingly, CSTARI Kolkata was entrusted to review power norms of the trades in consultation with trade experts.

Now, CSTARI has suggested that following revised power norms for above trades after consultation with trade experts:-

7.	Hair & Skin Care	14.0	4.0


The revised power norms for above trades are approved for implementation with immediate effect. The power norms for all other trades which were communicated vide letter dated 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2010, will remain unchanged.




