Subject - Evaluation of OMR answer sheets of Semester System All India Trade Test under CTS held in February-March, 2014.

Reference is made in reference to the letters no. DGE&T-19(4)/2011-CD(pt). Dated 16.11.2013, dated 3.1.2014 and no. DGE&T-19/01/2014-CD-(pt-II) dated 20.02.2014 regarding modified All India Trade Test procedure and amendments in Semester System regarding All India Trade Test held in February-March, 2014. After discussion with representative of U.P. Private ITI Management Association, it was decided that 10% grace marks to be given to candidates for this Semester to enable them to pass the examination easily. Later on, an option was given to students to attempt 80% of questions in those subjects where two subjects have been combined in the question paper.

In this connection, the evaluation procedure is given below considering the above amendments in the All India Trade Test held in February-March, 2014 under CTS System.

A: Engineering Trades

B) Non-Engineering Trades

C) It will be necessary for the candidate to secure a minimum of 40% marks in each paper and minimum 25% marks in each part separately. In case he/ she fails to do so the trainee shall be treated as failed in the semester and one more attempt would be allowed to him/ her to clear the paper.

D) As per the 80% option to the student, if he attempts all the questions then 80% correct questions may be taken for marking.

E) The 10% marks may be given separately to each subject as given in the above table. After giving grace marks the Total Marks should be minimum passing marks of the subject.

In order to understand the above evaluation procedure, some examples are given:-


(1) Example:- If the student gets 67.5 in Trade Theory and 12.5 marks in Employability Skills. The Total marks in paper-I of this student is $67.5+12.5=80$ then there is no need to give grace marks as he has already passed with minimum 40% marks required in paper-I.

(2) Example:- if the candidate gets 50 marks in Trade theory and 17 marks in Employable Skill then 10 grace marks may be allotted for theory subject and 3 marks may be allotted for Employable Skill to him for making minimum 40% passing marks which is $60+20=80$ marks.

(3) Example:- If the candidate gets 70 marks in Trade Theory 10 marks in Employable Skill then no grace mark may be allotted for theory subject and 2.5 marks may be allotted for Employable Skill to him for making minimum 25% in each subject. The total marks may be $70+12.5=82.5$ marks.

In view of above, the NIELIT may follow the above procedure for evaluation of the OMR sheets of semester system All India Trade Test under CTS held in February-March, 2014.


