Sub: Expediting the process of re-affiliation of ITIs & to forward action plan -
 reg.

Sir/Mam

As you are aware Industrial Training Institutes play a vital role in economy of the country especially in terms of providing skilled manpower. These ITIs were set up long back and need re affiliation in order to ensure infrastructural facilities as per today's industry demand. In this context, vide our Secretary' letter dated-9.4.2014 addressed to the Chief Secretaries, it was advised to apply online on QCI web-portal adhering to following schedule:-

In this endeavor, it is informed that Quality Council of India has been advised to extend all its cooperation and based upon the problems highlighted by the some of States/institutes, DGE&T has also suitably reviewed norms for re-affiliation.

Modified norms for instructors for re-affiliation of ITIs are as follows:

- ✓ New Principals & instructors appointed in Private ITIs after 1.7.2014 & in Govt. ITIs, after 1.7.2015 should be as per NCVT norms. The Principals & instructors appointed before the above mentioned dates would be exempted from qualification point of view. Additional year is given to Govt. ITIs as change in Recruitment Rules (RRs) and also selection process consumes time by State Government/ service commission.
- ✓ Instructors, who were appointed before five years (i.e., before year 2009), should be trained under the Crafts Instructor Training Scheme (CITS) before Aug 2016. Instructors, who are superannuating in June 2018 or before, should be exempted from training under CITS. Other instructors appointed during past five year (2009-2014) should be trained under CITS before Aug 2017.
- ✓ Principals of the Government ITIs are authorized to sign on plan layout in place of registered Architect.

It is worth mentioning here that State of the Odisha has already sent their action plan along with status of their application on QCI web-portal.

In view of above, you are requested to expedite the process of online application on QCI web-portal of Govt. & Pvt. ITIs as per schedule & forward your action plan at the earliest to this Directorate General. A statement of number of ITIs due for re-affiliation by August 2015, is annexed herewith for ready reference.
