Scheme for One Time Settlement Special scheme

Terms and conditions

1. Consumers having arrears for a period more than two years will only be eligible for settlement. This scheme will be open to all eligible consumers including those cases in which Revenue recovery action is initiated by KSEBL. This scheme will also be open to those eligible consumers where the arrears are in dispute and are pending before courts.
2. The scheme shall be open to consumers up to 31.3.2017.
3. The consumers opting for one Time settlement scheme shall remit the Principal in lump sum. However, on deserving cases such as Government departments, Public sector undertakings, Government institutions, local bodies, other deserving consumers having long pending arrears etc, instalments for Principal amount shall be provided with the approval of Full time Directors. Six months installments shall be provided for remitting interests.
4. For outstanding arrears exceeds 5 years, the interest rate applicable shall be 6% and for arrears between 2 years and 5 years, the applicable interest rate shall be 8%.
5. Minimum demand charges/fixed charges demanded can be limited to a period of six months after disconnection if the connection is dismantled.
6. In the case of Industrial units/Plantations which have different spells of closure (intermittent period of closure) the MD charges /fixed charges may be limited for a period of six months from the date of disconnection in each spell of closure.
7. No charges shall be levied after due date of dismantling except by way of minimum guaranteed /rental liabilities, if the connection is dismantled.
8. In case a connection is dismantled and accounts settled under this scheme and the party wants the connection to be re-effected subsequently, they have to apply for fresh connection.
9. For settlement of arrears where RR action has already been initiated, the consumer shall have to remit the collection charges as demanded by the Revenue department additionally.
10. The settlement of arrears under litigation shall be done subject to the withdrawal of court cases if any.

11. Application from LT consumers who opt for this scheme shall be accepted in the concerned Electrical Section. The cases shall be forwarded to concerned Deputy Chief Engineers of Electrical circles for settlement. Deputy Chief Engineers of Electrical Circles shall be authorized to settle arrears of LT consumers without any financial limit. However, if instalments for principal is required by LT consumers the same shall be taken up with Full time Directors through Director (Distribution & Safety).
12. Application from HT/EHT consumers who opt for this scheme shall be accepted in the office of the Special Officer (Revenue). The cases shall be put up to Full Time Directors for settlement. Full time Directors shall be authorized to settle the arrears of EHT, HT consumers.
13. Public relations officer /Deputy Chief Engineers shall give wide publicity regarding the scheme.
14. Cases already settled under previous schemes will not be reopened.
15. This scheme is not applicable for settling theft cases charged under Section 135 of Electricity Act 2003.
16. The following time frame shall be followed for implementation

15.12.2016	Intimation shall be given to each eligible consumer clearly indicating the savings the consumer can get on opting the scheme. The Senior Superintendent at Section Level and Special Officer (Revenue) at Corporate level will be responsible for intimating the consumers. The Accounts officer, Arrear Clearance, Ceil, O/o the Chief Internal Auditor shall intimate the details of the scheme directly to the Head of all government departments, Public sector units, Government institutions and Local Bodies.
2.1.2017	Start date to issue demand notice
25.3.2017	Last date of receiving application form
31.3.2017	Last date to issue demand notice & Last date of remittance by the consumer to avail the One time settlement Scheme. The applicant may approach KSEBL as early as possible to ensure adequate time period to remit the amount by the last date.

17. **For those opting for Full settlement** Full settlement means remittance of entire Principal amount plus total interest at the rate applicable for special OTS within the time granted. In such cases a rebate of 2% of interest amount as per the special OTS will be granted to the applicant.
18. **For those opting for installment facility** Principal plus 1st installment of interest in normal cases. In case installment for principal is required, the same will be decided by the Full Time Directors on a case to case basis.
19. Reconnection shall be effected only after remitting the principal amount in full.
