Government vide order read (2) above had recognized the
Secondary / Senior Secondary Examination Certificates issued by
National Institute of Open Schooling as equivalent to the certificates
issued by the Secondary / Higher Secondary boards of State of Kerala
Subject to the following conditions.

(i) In the case of Secondary Education the candidates of NIOS
should have studied two languages, Social Science /Psychology,
Science and Mathematics and Should have obtained a grade not below
D+ for each subject.

(ii) One of the two languages at the Secondary level should be
Malayalam.

(iii) In the case of Senior Secondary Education the candidates of
NIOS should have studied two languages and 3 optional subjects and
should have obtained grade not below D+ for each subject.

(iv) The candidates should have completed the age of 18 years for senior secondary and 16 years for the secondary as on 1st June of the year of Passing.

Director SC Development Department, Principals of ITIs and individuals as per their letters read above, requested clarification regarding the selection of candidates who possess the certificate of NIOS for III Admission.

In the above circumstance, the following guide lines are ordered for the admission session started from August 2012.

(a) The marks scored for the subjects English, Science (Theory + Practical) and Mathematics should be taken for calculating the index mark by taking 100 marks for each.

(b) Index marks will be calculated taking English as the language whenever English marks is available. In the absence of English Subject the highest marks of the regional language as per the 8th schedule of the constitution is to be taken for calculating index marks.

(c) As per the conditions (iii) in the GO read (2) above, Senior Secondary Examination Certificate under open school can be considered for calculating index mark as in the existing system adopted in +2 certificates.

(d) The conditions mentioned in the G.O. read (2) above should be born in mind while considering open school certificates.

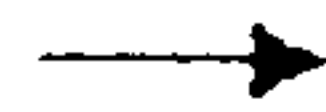
ORDER

As per the letter first cited, the Regional Director, Regional Centre, National Institute of Open Schooling, MHRD, Government of India, Kochi has requested for recognising Secondary/Senior Secondary Certificates issued by NIOS as equivalent to the Certificates issued by respective State Boards. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to recognise the Secondary/Senior Secondary Examination Certificates issued by National Institute of Open Schooling as equivalent to the Certificates issued by the Secondary/Higher Secondary Boards of State of Kerala respectively subject to the following conditions:

i) In the case of Secondary Education, the candidates of NIOS should have studied two languages, Social Science/ Psychology, Science and Mathematics and should have obtained a grade not below D+ (30% score) for each subject.

ii) One of the two languages at the Secondary level should be Malayalam. This condition is applicable to those candidates registering for Secondary Education from the academic year 2011-12 onwards.

iii) In the case of Senior Secondary Education; the candidates of NIOS should have studied two languages and three optional subjects and should have obtained a grade not below D+ (30% score) for each subject.



iv) the candidates should have completed the age of 18 years for the Senior Secondary level and 16 years for the Secondary level as on 1st June of the year of passing.
