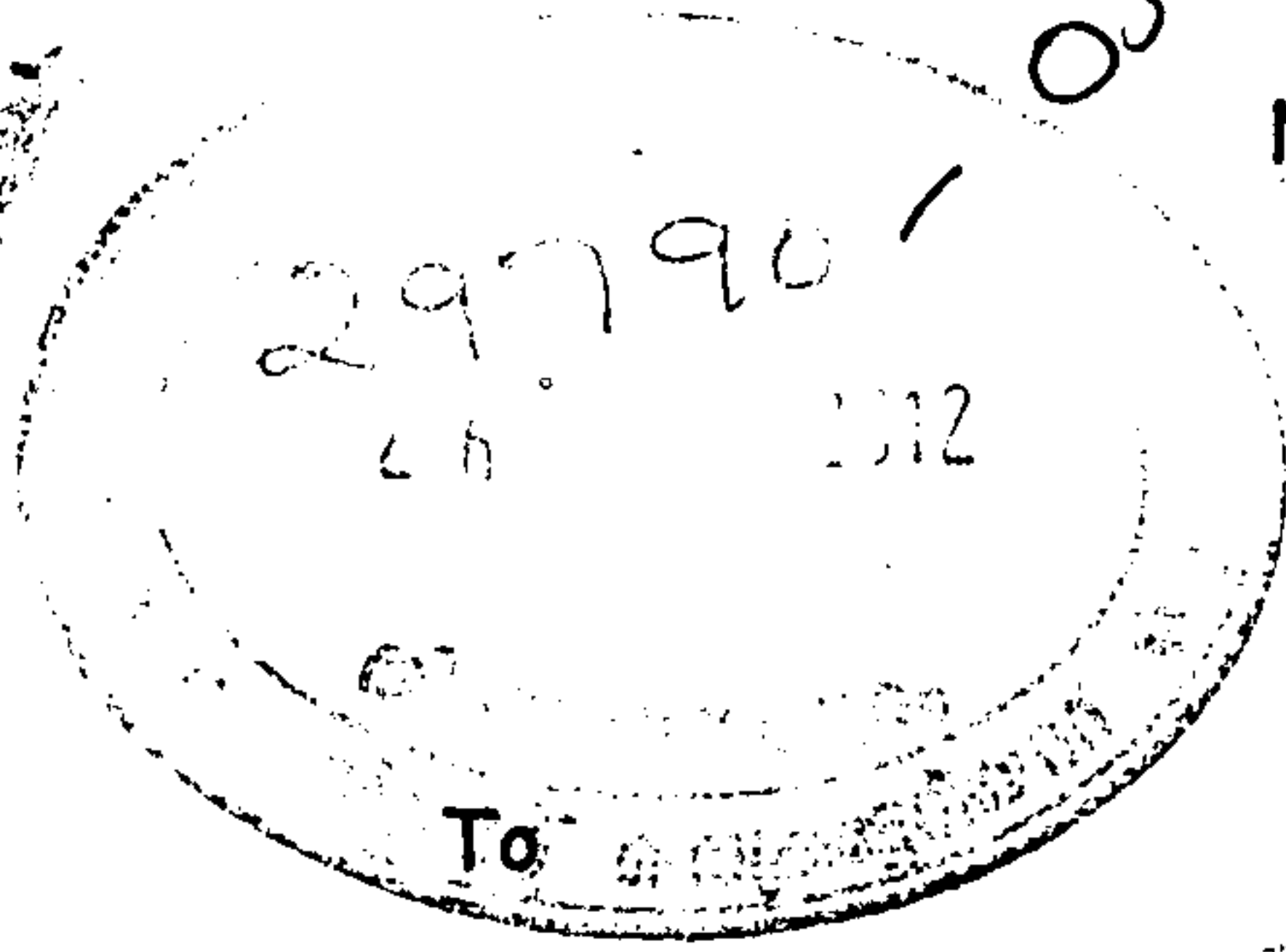

Sir/Madam,

Kindly refer to the meeting held under the Chairmanship of Union Secretary, Labour & Employment, on 7-12-2012 in DGE&T, New Delhi wherein issue relating to allowing the trainees of ITIs to undergo training in the modules under Skill Development Initiative (SDI) Scheme was discussed in detail. It was suggested by the States/UTs that trainees of ITIs may allowed to acquire skills in other disciplines in order to improve their employability. After detailed deliberations, it was decided that trainees of ITIs may be allowed to undergo training in modules under SDI Scheme under following conditions:-

1. Trainees may not be allowed to undergo training in modules under SDI Scheme simultaneously alongwith his/her regular training schedule in ITIs. i.e. if a trainee is undergoing Craftsmen Training in ITI from 9.00 AM to 5.00 PM, he /she can undergo training in modules under SDI after 5.00 PM or before 9.00 AM. In this connection, instructions were issued vide letter no. DGET-2/2/2007-MES/IS(Part) dated 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2011 by which it was directed that all government and private ITIs may run MES courses in third shift by engaging contract faculty and using the services of existing faculty members by paying them additional remuneration provided they possess expertise in those modules. Trainees from outside can also be enrolled in the third shift for training under MES courses.
2. Trainees may be allowed to take training in those modules under SDI scheme other than those under CTS in which they are undergoing training i.e. if a trainee is undergoing Craftsmen Training in trade "Fitter" in ITI, he / she will not be allowed to take training in modules relating to Fitter.
3. The objective of getting training under MES modules should be to provide the trainee additional skills which are not covered under CTS and can make him better employable.



4. Separate register and account should be maintained for MES training by the Principal of ITI and funds reimbursed under SDI Scheme shall be used for enhancing facilities for MES training, procurement of tools, equipment, machinery, raw material, pedagogy tools, payment of honorarium to trainers, etc.
