Regarding

Government of India have introduced Skill Development Initiative Scheme under Modular Employable Skills Scheme of the DGE&T, New Delhi for skilling youths for making themselves employable/more employable . The Scheme envisages the upliftment of school dropouts, ITI graduates, traditionally skilled but uncertified workers by skilling them by imparting training of a few hundred hours focusing on the basic skill gap and certifying them after conducting a skill test. This is a special case in which Government envisages optimum use of infrastructural facilities and human resource available in existing institutes/ Industries without affecting the normal functioning and a rare opportunity to make the youths of India, especially the neglected group for gaining skills at different levels in various sectors so that they can earn a better livelihood .
